

浩二さんの意見

I like talking on the phone better than writing letters.

First, speaking on the phone is faster than writing a letter. If we have five minutes, how much can we write? ① Not much. But we can talk a lot on the phone in five minutes.

Second, if we send a letter, we have to wait for a few days to get an answer, but on the phone, we don't have to wait. ② If I want to get an answer soon, I will use the phone.

Third, when I talk with my friend on the phone, I will know how he feels from his voice and way of talking. Sometimes our voice shows our true feelings.

I like writing letters better.

Writing is sometimes easier for me than speaking because I am very shy. When it is difficult to say something to my friend, I write it in a letter.

Also, I like letters because we can keep them for a long time. When I've read letters from my friends, I keep them and later (⑤) them again. To me, letters from my friends are my treasure. So, I write my letters with all my heart.

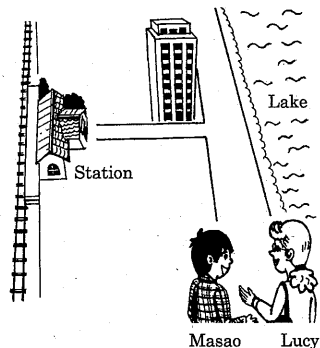
